Checklist:

- _____ Daily wear should be 'comfortable and cute' pant, capri or short sets. Dresses are always acceptable. Appropriate shoe. Please no tennis shoes or flip flops on Day 2 or Day3.

- _____ Day 4 ends with Photoshoots. Each camper will do a 3-look photoshoot so, be prepared with at least 4-6 outfits to be considered. Please see the enclosed Photoshoot Preparation flyer. Looks suggested would be...casual, dressy, sporty. Kids can bring props for these different outfits such as school books and glasses, sports equipment, lunch bag, kite, etc. You may bring these items in the morning or they may be dropped off in the time period scheduled.

- _____ Books will be given to each student at the start of the program and we ask that they stay in the classroom. At the end of camp, they may be then taken home by each camper.

- _____ If you didn't include a picture with your registration materials, please bring one to registration.

- _____ Health Form *enclosed, please complete and bring to registration.

- _____ Mannequin Modeling will be held Day 3 at Macy's Kid's Section in West Acres. Parents are welcome to observe, take pictures, etc. Parents are asked to find the Director to 'check out' with their child. *see confirmed schedule

- _____ Swimsuit, Towel, Sunglasses, Sunscreen, Small change for concession allowed *August Session Only
